

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What should my camper wear to summer camp?

Campers should wear loose fitting, light-weight, and, if possible, light-colored clothing. All campers must wear sneakers. **Flip-flops and sandals are permitted on pool days only.** We will specify in the weekly camp newsletter when swimsuits and/or any additional clothing are needed.

2. Will my camper need a snack and lunch?

YES! Unless otherwise stated, all campers should bring a morning snack, bagged lunch, and water bottle to camp each day. Hot lunch will be available for purchase several days during the camp weeks. The details will be provided in the weekly camp newsletter.

Please note that hot lunch is not available to those campers enrolled in adventure camps.

3. How will I receive information about upcoming camps?

Each Friday, the weekly camp newsletter will be emailed to all those campers registered for the upcoming week. The newsletter will provide the itinerary for that week; any links or information about any waivers that must be completed; and the available lunch options.

4. What happens if I do not complete a required waiver?

Some activities, whether on or off campus, require a waiver signed by a parent or guardian. If your child does not have a completed and signed waiver form, then he/she will not

be allowed to participate in that camp for the day. Refunds will not be issued.

5. Is camp open the week of July 4th?

Mark your calendars. **Holy Trinity Summer Camp will be closed Monday, June 29th through Friday, July 3rd.** We will reopen Monday, July 6th. (Week 4 of our 8-week program).

6. What if my child needs medication during his/her week at your camp?

You are responsible for providing Holy Trinity Summer Camp with any and all medications needed to keep your child safe while in our camp. Medications must be clearly labeled and in their original packaging. All medications must also be accompanied by the Maryland State Medication Administration Authorization Form. And, if necessary, the medications must be accompanied by an Allergy or Asthma Action Plan. **Holy Trinity Summer Camp has the right to refuse your child's enrollment in camp if the proper medications and paperwork are not provided.**

7. What are the morning drop-off procedures?

Summer Camp is held on the Daisy Lane Campus and begins at 9:00AM each day. The camp day ends at 3:00PM.

ROOTED HAWKS

Parents are asked to walk their campers directly to The Daisy Lane School (Pre-School) wing of the building, through the main entrance. The counselors will meet these campers in the classroom.

GROWING AND FLYING HAWKS

Both Primary School and High School Prep campers are to walk themselves to the gathering space in the 5th. / 6th. grades wing of the school. The attendance will be taken for each camp and the campers will be dismissed to their respective counselors accordingly.

CAMPERS ARRIVING BEFORE 8:45AM

ROOTED HAWKS are to be escorted to The Daisy Lane School wing. They are to be signed in with the Extended Day staff. **GROWING AND FLYING HAWKS** will be directed to the appropriate classrooms, within the High School Prep area of the school, where they will be signed in with the Extended Day staff. Arriving before 8:45AM will incur additional charges.

8. What are the afternoon pick-up procedures?

Carline begins at approximately 3:05PM. Counselors will be available in the parking lot to assist in directing traffic and creating two rows for cars to line up in front of the main doors. Staff members will bring the campers out and assist with them getting safely to their cars. There is no need for parents of Growing and Flying Hawks parents to come into the building.

The parents of Rooted Hawks are asked to come into the building. Counselors will be waiting at the main office with these campers. These are the only campers who will not participate in carline.

9. What if I want to pick up my camper early?

We ask that you call the summer camp office and let us know what time we should have your camper ready for dismissal. Early dismissals can be scheduled no later than 2:30PM.

10. What if my camper only has a half-day camp?

Growing and Flying Hawks are the only groups with the option of half-day camps. Those enrolled in a morning only camp must be picked up from the main office by noon. Those enrolled in an afternoon only camp cannot be dropped off to the main office before noon.
