The 2023–2024 Development Campaign was a success as we continued our efforts in building community. Through engagement events and fundraising initiatives, together we gave our time, talent, and treasure to ensure our students become **The Best You!**

This philanthropic effort facilitates a well-rounded program that includes exceptional courses of study, outstanding fine arts and athletic offerings, and essential professional development opportunities for faculty and staff. It also augments financial aid, keeps tuition

affordable, and maintains an admirable student/teacher ratio.

The school year began with our Circles of Conversation event where parents, faculty, and board members joined together to discuss the social and emotional needs of our youth, as a community.

Our fundraising activities during the 2023-2024 Development Campaign focused on The Annual Fund for Excellence, as well as Holy Trinity's Fall and Spring fundraisers like DoubleGood Popcorn, Sponsored Spelling, Bowie Baysox game, and Reading for Education. We also celebrated 60 years of Holy Trinity through our 60th Anniversary Campaign and Derby party!

We are pleased to report the blessings of our community of families, friends, corporate sponsors and donors in raising \$86,080 to Holy Trinity's 2023–2024 Development Campaign. We are filled with gratitude and could not have done this without your support!



The Annual Fund for Excellence represents our most important community year-long philanthropic endeavor. All families are informed about the Annual Fund for Excellence in hopes that everyone will participate.

Our collective effort raises funds to help offset the gap between tuition and the cost of providing for our children's education through the current school year, as tuition covers just 80% of our operating budget. The Annual Fund for Excellence, along with other generated revenue streams, helps offset the remaining 20%.

SPONSORED SPELLING

Our annual Spring fundraiser, Holy Trinity's Sponsored Spelling, was a great success. Surpassing our goal of \$25,000, our community collectively raised \$30,508! Holy Trinity's Sponsored Spelling fundraiser is a written spelling bee. Students receive vocabulary lists, with the complexity varying by grade level. Kindergarten through eighth grade students studied their lists in preparation for the test on March 22nd. Parents and students solicited their family, friends, and community for sponsorship pledges and donations to their fundraising page. Incentives for those who raised \$150+ for kindergarten and \$250+ for first through eighth were as follows: 1st through 8th grade students received a \$75 Amazon gift card and kindergarten students received a \$25 Barnes & Noble gift card. Congratulations to the 72 students that met or surpassed their incentive.

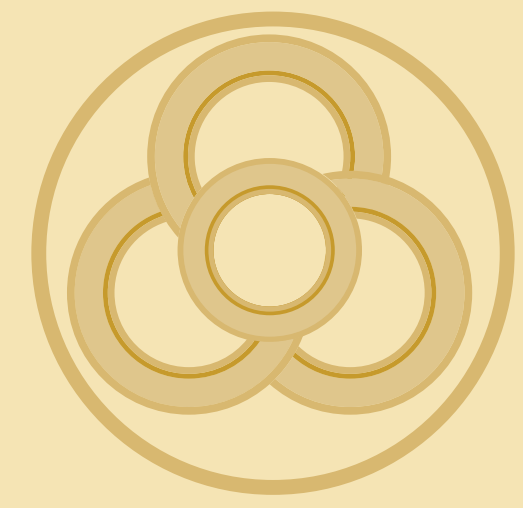
